



Campers' information 2026

Location, checking in, and checking out

Sacrewell is just off the A1/A47 junction – please follow the brown tourist signs rather than your Sat Nav.

Your pitch will be available from 1pm on the day of arrival. Please arrive before 8pm. Please vacate your pitch by midday on the final day of your stay, to allow our next campers to settle in without delays.

During the visitor centre opening hours, please call in at reception for your welcome pack. After closing time, your welcome pack will be left for you in the container on the campers' noticeboard at the front of the visitor centre. Any wristbands will be available for collection when the visitor centre opens the following day.

Admission to the farm

If you are accessing the farm during your stay, wristbands must be worn at all times. You will not be able to gain access to the farm without these being worn. Please show your wristband to the reception team each time you enter the farm. If you lose a wristband, a new one will need to be purchased at full price. Any damaged bands need to be brought back to reception, and it is at our discretion if they are replaced or whether a new one will need to be purchased. Wristbands are non-transferrable and must not be shared between multiple guests.

If you have not added camper's admission to your booking, you will need to purchase general admission at reception if you wish to enter the farm.

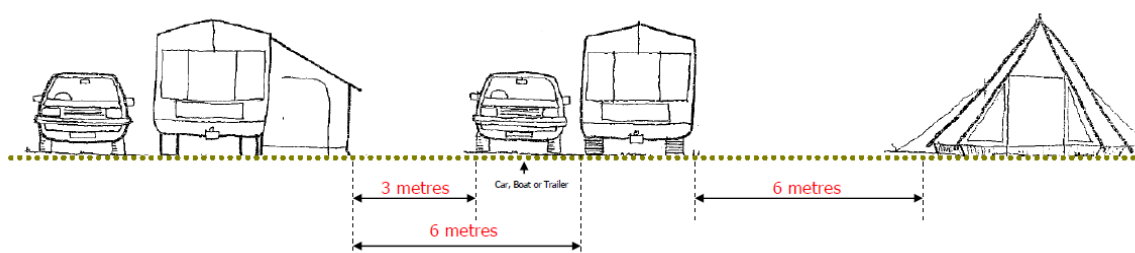

Barrier code

The campsite barrier is lowered during the evening and raised early in the morning. The barrier code will be given on arrival please call the office on 01780 782254 if you are arriving after 4.30pm.

Setting up

Electric hook-up pitches are clearly numbered. Please pitch, as shown, in front of your pitch number post. Motorhomes are required to reverse into the space to enable them to drive out forwards in the event of an issue on the site. Please ensure there is a minimum of 6m between any unit/awning and the next pitch. Only one car is permitted per pitch, additional cars can be left in the main car park – please ask in reception for a parking permit.



Visitors without electric hook-up are welcome to choose where on the allocated field area they would like to pitch, allowing a six-metre gap between your unit and your neighbour's unit.

Please ask a member of the reception team if you need any assistance.

Emergencies

The nearest hospital open 24 hours is Peterborough City Hospital located at PE3 9GZ which is around 7 miles from Sacrewell. The nearest police station is Thorpe Wood Police Station located at PE3 6SD.

Shopping

Our gift shop stocks a selection gifts, toys, books and small camping items. The nearest village shop is the Post Office in Wansford village (just under a mile away). The nearest supermarket is Sainsbury's in Bretton Centre, Peterborough PE3 8DA.

The closest petrol station is near to our entrance on the A47.

Food and drink

Our on-site café, The Farmhouse Table is open daily for breakfast, hot and cold meals, drinks, sandwiches and snacks.

A few rules and requests

Please be considerate to your fellow campers and keep noise to a minimum after 9pm.

Well-behaved dogs are welcome but please make sure they are kept on a lead and that you clear up after them. Maximum 3 dogs per pitch.

Barbecues must be raised off the ground and attended by an adult at all times. Sorry, no generators or campfires are allowed. Firepits are only permitted on designated pitches.

Bins are located at the back of the Playbarn - please separate recyclable waste from general waste.

Please leave the toilet and shower blocks as you would expect to find them.

Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult on the campsite, play area, and when visiting the farm.

No unauthorised access to the farm site during closed hours. You must not access the site through restricted gates and over fences.

We reserve the right to ask you to leave, without a refund, if you violate these guidelines.
